Bishop Richard introduced his clear coherent response to a year of consultation within the Diocese. After the Concelebrated Mass at the Cathedral in Arundel on Tuesday, he and his team presented it to the assembly in the hall, with the title "The Word Who Is Life". His intention is to visit each deanery, having an open meeting for all those wishing to attend. His desire is that his plan is presented to the Diocese, so that there is an opportunity for all of us to work together to bring the mission of the church to our homes and our parishes.
