Fr Rory Writes:

Please God, and with the help of God we will move on through the new year, in keeping with Bishop Richard's Pastoral Plan "The Word Who is Life", continue to develop and grow our faith. The most important thing is that it is the good news of God's salvation and not merely a safety net, or something to benefit us as a passport to a better education.

Over the years we have established parish councils for our two communities, which work well to support and help the life of our parish. We now need to develop a structure to provide leadership for a new generation in keeping with Bishop Richard's plan. There is a need for a fresh impetus. Previously I arranged two dates without sufficient consultation, so they did not materialise. I am aware of the reality that those who are working a new generation through the children's liturgy are up to their eyes in work, so I do not expect to be inundated with suggestions, but we need fresh help and a Saturday morning appears to me to offer the best chance. I am fully open to offers of help and suggestions.
