So I encourage those who are preparing to receive the sacraments; who help with The Children's Liturgy; Ministers of the Word and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and every other ministry to come along, even if it does involve an extra, extra effort.

It is an important opportunity for all of us to pray together for the future of our parish, we need a new generation in the life of our parish community in order to grow.
